

Town of Stamford Cemetery Commission

A meeting of the Stamford Cemetery Commission was called to order at 2:00 PM, December 11, 2017.

Members present: Sally Bohl, Janice Farinon and Mary Lou Wright. Member Sheila Pecor arrived at 2:50 PM.

The minutes of the May 12th meeting were reviewed. Mary Lou Wright made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Janice Farinon seconded the motion which was approved with no opposition.

Sally Bohl proposed to defer registration paperwork until 2018. A discussion regarding bank statements was also deferred to await the end of year totals.

There were nine burials in 2017. A number of these burial plots had never been pinned. It was decided to raise the selling price of cemetery plots by \$50.00 to provide funding for the pinning. This will be done immediately after the sale. Future by-laws will reflect this. A motion by Mary Lou Wright was made to approve this. The motion was seconded by Janice Farinon and passed unanimously.

Repairs to the stone wall and steps in the Millard were made in May 2017. Additionally, several corner markers were resealed and lowered to prevent mowing mishaps. Vermont Stone Works provided this service. Some repair of driveway and parking areas was also performed by Barry Berard at Millard Cemetery.


In 2018, the commission hopes to proceed with an expensive but necessary stone cleaning project.
