Survey Update

92 surveys have been completed and a majority of respondents (over 70%) favor creating more of a “town center” in Stamford and adding an outdoor gathering space to be located on the town office/school property. Additional surveys will be distributed as opportunities arise.

Selectboard Presentation

On behalf of the Stamford **BUILDING COMMUNITY** Committee, Pat and Victoria will present the building project proposal to the Stamford Selectboard on July 19. A document that Bill will hand deliver to selectboard members at their July 12 meeting was reviewed. The purpose of the document is to give the selectboard members enough background on the project to allow for the short presentation at the July 19 meeting to focus on achieving the following goals:

- Fully inform the selectboard of project goals and progress-to-date
- Gain selectboard support for moving forward with the project
- Identify actions necessary to gain and sustain town approval and support over the life of the project

Pat will incorporate suggested changes and additions to the selectboard presentation document. She will also review the last two town plans and share with the selectboard any content that is relevant to the proposed project.

Victoria shared new sketches of ideas for signage, landscaping, and seating in front of the school/town office. The sketches will be among those shared with the selectboard.

Caroline will make inquiries regarding landscape architects who may offer services at no cost to the town as part of an educational program.
