JOB DESCRIPTION HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LABORER TOWN OF STAMFORD, VERMONT

The Highway Department Laborer position requires a versatile person with many areas of expertise with particular mechanical skills and ability to lift heavy objects. (Pre-employment physical may be required) Class B Commercial Drivers' Licenses (CDL) with air brakes will be required within 6 months of hire as well as random drug and alcohol testing. Pre-employment testing required. The Highway Department Laborer must have the ability to perform job duties in all environmental conditions.

WORK HOURS:

Full time, 6:00 a.m. through 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The hours during snow removal season will be ANY HOUR (DAY OR NIGHT) as required by existing conditions. The Highway Department Laborer must be able to report to work within 30 minutes of being contacted by phone during the on-call season.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

1. Report to the Road Commissioner daily to organize work day flow.
2. Operate grader, mower, loader, truck, sander and any other maintenance equipment.
3. Perform preventative maintenance on all equipment.
4. Repair equipment when determined more cost effective to do so.
5. Maintain and repair town buildings as required.
6. Recycling responsibilities as required.
7. Suggest road work projects to the Road Commissioner as appropriate.
8. Other related duties as assigned.
